Project Information

OC San will rehabilitate over two miles of regional sewer pipe on Western Avenue and Orange Avenue in the cities of Buena Park, Anaheim, and Cypress. As part of this project 35 manholes will be replaced or rehabilitated. A segment of pipe on Orange Avenue will also be replaced to address pipe deficiencies.

This project is needed to enhance aging infrastructure and extend the life of the regional sewer system.

What to Expect:

As construction occurs, it will be necessary to make modifications to traffic flow. For your safety and that of our crews, please follow all posted signs.

- Nightwork and occasional weekend work
- Noise and dust
- Lane and crosswalk closures
- Potential bus stop relocations
- Occasional turn restrictions
- Street parking restrictions
