Dear Representative Correa:

On behalf of the Orange County Sanitation District (OC San), thank you for your leadership and success in securing OC San's Fiscal Year 2023 Community Project request for the Supercritical Water Oxidation project. The opportunity to secure the federal assistance will help us to demonstrate a PFAS destruction technology that will help us protect the citizens of Orange County, its natural resources and provide other communities across the nation with a proven treatment technology.

As noted in our original request, your success will support a six-ton-per-day demonstration project called AirSCWO Nix6. This process uses water at a high temperature and pressure to oxidize and break down complex compound materials like PFAS. Once treated, we expect that the compounds are transformed into more basic and benign compounds and ensure enhanced public health including exposure from water and air that would otherwise contain PFAS. When operational, AirSCWO Nix6 may provide opportunities to solve other challenges facing OC San and other clean water agencies throughout California. Our work may also help address environmental and public health concerns related to treating microplastics, reducing greenhouse gas emissions, and increasing the efficiency of the treatment process, while also reducing solids processing costs.

Again, thank you for supporting OC San's mission to improve Orange County's water quality and protecting public health.
